

Navigating Change: How FRIENDS of the Blue Ridge shifted their organizational focus in 2021 to improving Blue Rudge communities along the Parkway in Virginia and North Carolina and what that impact looks like.

Julie is a native of Texas who attended high school in Buffalo, NY. She earned her business degree from the University of Notre Dame where she met her husband, PJ. With over 20 years of membership marketing experience, primarily with nonprofits, she has been with FRIENDS for over 5 years. Frank Maguire is the Greenway Coordinator for the Roanoke Valley Greenways Commission and will be speaking on the Roanoke Valley Greenways: Past, Present, and Future. 


**April 19th Club Meeting - Jimmy Butler**

presenting No Kid Sleeps on the Floor in Our Town. It will be a discussion about children in the Roanoke Valley who don't have a bed of their own to sleep in.


