One \$5,000 scholarship will be awarded by the Kiwanis Club of Roanoke in the Spring/Summer of 2025 to a local student* attending Virginia Tech, Ferrum College, Hollins University, or Roanoke College who is majoring or pursuing a graduate degree in environmental protection or natural resource management. The nominee/applicant must be a rising junior, rising senior, senior, or graduate student whose chosen major/field of study is environmentally related as described herein. The award will be based on the information provided in this nomination/application form, a current transcript, a nomination letter or letter of recommendation from a faculty member in your major field, and a personal narrative statement (see essay requirements below). Award criteria include financial need, academic experience in environmental protection or natural resources management, and goals after graduation. An interview of finalists by the Kiwanis Environmental Scholarship Selection Committee selected by the Kiwanis Club of Roanoke may be required.

4. Goals after graduation (ideal job, preferred location, additional schooling desired, connection or continuing ties to the Roanoke Valley, etc.)

Letter of Nomination/Recommendation: Please submit a letter of nomination (faculty) or request a letter of recommendation (student) from a faculty member of your preference within your chosen field of environmental study or natural resource management from whom you have taken at least one class. This letter should be submitted directly to the Kiwanis Club of Roanoke at either the email or the mailing address above. This letter is not to be submitted by or through the applicant student.
