The Kiwanis Club of Roanoke will again, in 2026, award scholarships to seniors from among six area high schools. Awards totaling \$20,000 will be made – one for **\$6,000**, one for **\$4,000** and **four** additional awards of **\$2,500**.

We ask that you encourage those students with strong **school and community volunteer service**, good **academic achievement**, and who have **financial need** to apply.

Attached is the scholarship application. Please use this to make copies for interested applicants. You may also share the website link and QR code found below for the option to use a fillable pdf application form and the option to use an online application form. **Applications are due on March 13, 2026.** Your Kiwanis Scholarship Committee liaison will pick up the completed hardcopy applications from you on Friday, March 13. Applicants have the option to return the hardcopy applications via email to roanokekiwanis@gmail.com. A panel of Kiwanis members will individually read each application, and we will notify all applicants and counselors of the results of our decisions during the week of April 13.

The six finalists will be interviewed in April to determine which scholarship award each will receive. The awards will be presented at a Kiwanis Club luncheon in May with their parents, counselors, principals, and school superintendents invited. Each student will be asked to address the club briefly. All finalists are required to participate in the in-person interview and expected to attend award ceremony. Any exceptions must be addressed with the scholarship committee in advance.
